EVENT GOALS

Led by MSU's College of Education, the Resilient Education Systems convening will bring together leaders from the Asia Hub network and across Asia's academic and policy sectors. The goal is to explore opportunities and challenges in building resilient education systems in support of Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 4 to provide inclusive, quality and relevant educational opportunities for all.

We believe global partnerships among higher education institutions, policymakers, and civil society are essential to establishing resilient education systems. This convening builds on the efforts launched in 2025 to co-create solutions, share knowledge, and foster joint problem-solving. Beyond serving as a forum for exchange, the convening aims to deepen collaboration, identify new avenues for partnership, and grow the collective impact of education-focused efforts in the region.

The convening will feature plenary sessions by invited speakers and offer opportunities for focused discussions on pressing educational issues in the region, including supporting teachers and education leaders to enact change; supporting learners to succeed in school and beyond; and supporting processes to build resilient and equitable education systems. We will conclude the event by articulating next steps to continue and deepen collaborations, including strengthening the existing community of practice and seeking avenues of external funding and support to further various goals discussed.
